

There will be occasions during the school year where you will wish to take photographs or make a video recording your child or children taking part in a school activity.



We need to ensure that pictures and images taken of children are done in such a way that reflects the protective ethos of the school.

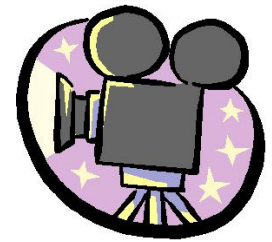
In order to do so, we need to ensure that parental use of photography and video is monitored and protected for the benefit of children and their parents.



We will ask you to do one or more of the following:

- ❑ You will be asked to sign giving permission for your child to be photographed during school activities.
- ❑ We will ask you to sign to indicate that any images (photographic or video) that you take will not be used inappropriately.
- ❑ We will inform you of designated areas where photography/video recording will be allowed. For example, in the main school hall where the performance is taking place.

- ❑ If using a video camera during school performances you will be asked to sit at the back of the room to prevent obscuring other people's view.



- ❑ We request that flash photography is not used during any performance since this can be very off-putting for the children.
